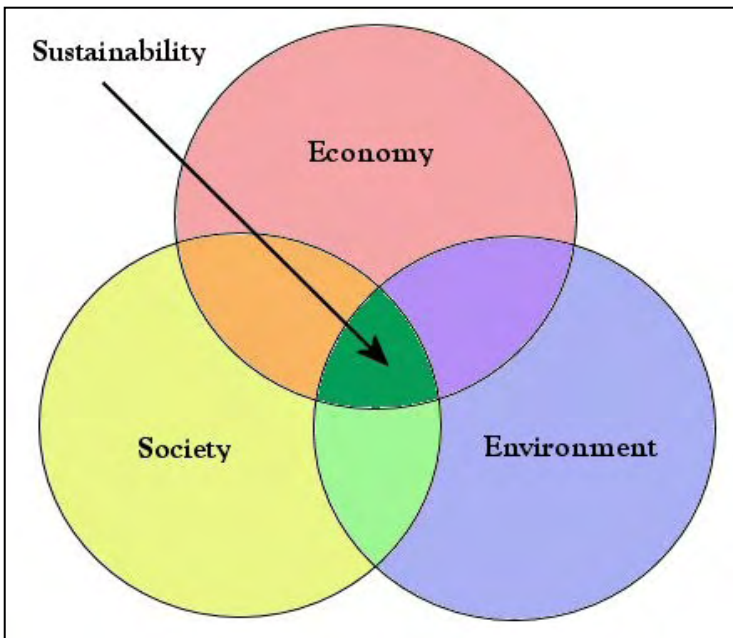


Sustainability: It Doesn't Mean Running Around in Circles!
